The Georgia Utility Contractors Association and the Georgia Department of Transportation (GDOT) will be offering training on construction staking and layout. This training course is formatted to give the participant a better understanding of the challenges GDOT, the roadway contractor and the utility owners face when attempting to retain or relocate utility facilities within the road right-of-way.

Topics covered will include:

- 1) Reading Plans
  - a. Attendee will have attained the basics to read GDOT highway plans at the end of the training.
- 2) Stakeholder's Responsibilities
  - a. Stakeholders will better understand how each of their roles impacts others in the construction of a GDOT road project.
- 3) Basic Knowledge of Construction Stakes
  - a. Attendee will have basic understanding of how to read a level instrument, rod and notation.
- 4) Specification 149
  - a. Attendee will benefit from the use of Spec. 149 to perform utility relocations.
